

PITTINI GROUP PROFILE

The **Pittini Group**, with headquarters in Osoppo, in the province of Udine, is a leader in the production of long steels for the construction and mechanical engineering industry. With an annual production of around 3 million tons, 18 production facilities and logistics service, and 1,800 employees, Pittini is a sound industrial reality oriented towards a constant growth, driven by high-tech investments, product innovation and a careful environmental sustainability policy.

The facilities manage the entire production cycle from a circular economy perspective: from the raw material (scrap) to the finished product with the production of billets, rolled concrete reinforcing products in bars, coils and wire rod. In 1995, the Pittini Group launched the **Zero Waste** project, with the aim of enhancing and recycling production waste. Thanks to **Zero Waste**, **Granella®**, an exclusive product by Pittini, is obtained from waste material coming from the steel mill. The product is used in the construction of road paving as an alternative to replace natural aggregates.

In 2015 the Pittini Group acquired Acciaierie di Verona, an industrial site with a long iron and steel tradition. Since 2017, a considerable renovation plan has been implemented, with a total of 100 million euros-worth of investments, designed to improve the quality of wire rods produced by the plant for the mechanical and construction industry.

In 2003 the Group set up its own **corporate school** "Officina Pittini per la Formazione". Established as a non-profit organization with the aim of providing collaborators with continuing education programs, it bears witness to the value that Pittini gives to developing professional skills as a lever for business growth and improvement.
